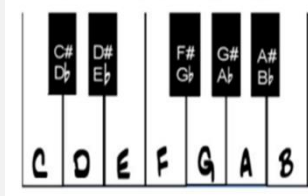
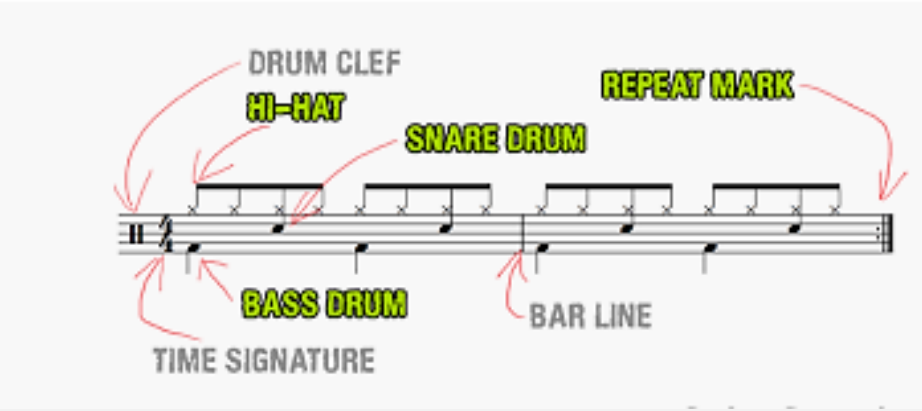


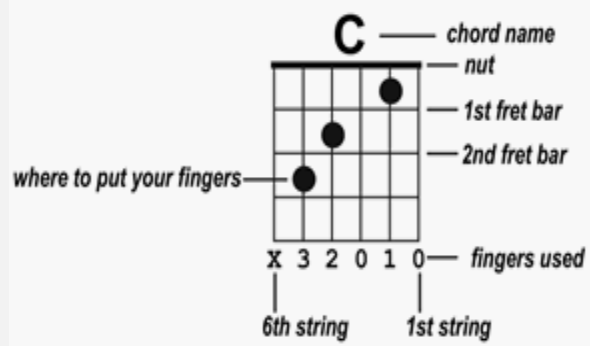
Key Words

Melody and Accompaniment	A melody and accompaniment texture is when you can clearly distinguish between the melody and accompaniment. This could be a pop song with a solo singer accompanied by a band
Broken Chords	When you play chords as separate notes.
Major	Sounds happy.
Minor	Sounds Sad.
Riff	A catchy repeating tune usually at the start of the song.
Block chords	When all the notes of a chord are played at the same time.
Intro/outro	Introduction to the song. Or the ending instrumental.
Instrumental	In the middle of the song the instruments will take over from the voice.
Verse	The part of the song which tells the story.
Chorus	The catchy, repetitive part of the song.
Bridge	Connects the verse and chorus with a different feel to the music.
