KEY LEARNING OBJECTIVES Learners will be able to:

- Copy the work of an artist. Pablo Picasso
- Study and discuss key characteristics within the artist's work and present findings
- -Use their knowledge and the characteristics of the artist's work within their own work as it develops.

Prior learning: Students will explore the formal elements of drawing and colour and put key skills from year 7 and year 8 into practice. A drawing they produce will appear in the final piece. They will also experiment with colour and explore different materials to gain knowledge around surface.

What can I take from this artist and how can I use it in my own work?


Make full use of prior knowledge.
