Levels	Can be used to suggest status
Unison	All Actors move in the same way ,at the same time.
Canon Movement	Actors repeat an action or movement in a sequence one after the other (like a Mexican Wave
Transitions	The Fluid and Focused movement between scenes to make your piece look professional.
Soundscape	Using your voices and bodies to create sound effects.
Narrative	The story line of a piece of drama.
Thought-tracking	Stepping out of the scene and saying what you are thinking to the audience.
Marking the Moment	Using freeze, frozen images or other devices to highlight a key moment in your piece.

DEVISING
When you make up your own piece of Drama

STIMULUS
The inspiration for your made up piece of Drama, this could be music, a poem, a picture etc.

DEVISING TECHNIQUES
The explorative skills used to perform you piece such as *still image, thought-tracking, flashback and narration.*
