Personal Development (PSHE) in Year 9

I wanted to write to you with regards to our PSHE (Personal, Social and Health Education) Curriculum at Saltash. I am sure that you are aware that RSHE (Relationships, Sex and Health Education) became compulsory in all schools in April 2021. We were already teaching many of the topics that have become part of the compulsory content but have adjusted our curriculum and increased delivery time to ensure that we are covering all of the necessary content preparing our students to be well rounded individuals prepared to embrace 21st Century life.

PSHE (Personal, Social & Health Education) encompasses Careers Education & Guidance and Citizenship and we have 3 Key concepts that we teach throughout all year groups within our school:

- ✓ Living in the wider world
- ✓ Health and well being
- ✓ Relationships

We study a broad range of topics across the year covering each of the three aspects of the subject, please see the attached programme for topic areas covered in Year 9. All students have one hour of PSHE a week in years 7-9, taught by a member of a specialist team ensuring that all content is well researched and delivered in an age appropriate way, allowing our students the opportunity to build on our school TEAM values. In addition to teacher delivery we welcome a number of quest speakers throughout the year to enhance our curriculum further.
